

The Miles To Go trio

In this compact version of the 7 piece "Miles To Go band" - one of Western Australia's classiest folk/roots acts, now in its 10th year and recently having received its 7th nomination for "Best World Music Act" at the WA Music Industry's "WAMi" awards - David Hyams is joined by cellist Anna Sarcich (cello) and Stuart Paterson, on wood flute, bodhran and whistle.

Flute, mandolin and cello come to the fore in the line up, while still capturing the essence of the larger ensemble pieces from the 'Miles To Go' and 'Knowing' the Place albums. The sound is also shaped by songs that add country-blues tinges to the celtic infused mix, and which continue to explore the places and stories of our vast landscape - from the stunning night sky of the Kimberley and the north's oceans of wilderness, to winding southern coastal tracks...

The trio have been living up to the 'Miles To Go' name so far in 2010, with their first tour to the USA, around the International Folk Alliance convention in Memphis, Tennessee. They have been invited to several Australian festivals in the latter part of 2010 and will be touring extensively across the country before the year is out.
